

PURPOSE: To redirect student behaviors and assisting them to learn positive actions to help them be more *Respectful, Responsible, and Ready*.

ACTION: Students will attend *REN Academy* for assigned amount of days to reflect, respond, and retrieve methods to help them replace negative behaviors with appropriate and positive actions.

PROGRAM DETAILS:

REN Academy will be conducted by an administrator or the school's SRO on set Tuesdays and Thursdays at Community Middle from 3:00-3:45 pm. Once assigned, guardian will arrange transportation and pick up student from the front office lobby. There will be further consequence if a student does not attend as assigned.

During the program, students will be asked to reflect on their patterns of behavior and learn how to replace them with appropriate positive behaviors designed to help support the students' achievements academically and socially.

Each student will be assigned an activity during the REN Academy that will directly align with the behavior. If a student has had issues with aggression or disrespect, for an example, then conflict resolution will be the focus.

The ultimate goal of the REN Academy will be to redirect unwanted behaviors and support our REN expectations for all students to be *Respectful, Responsible, and Ready* at all times in various situations. This program will help students remain in class for instruction while still benefiting from an assigned consequence.
